#### 01. Postgraduate Diploma in Buddhist Studies Course (P.G.D.) (01 year)

(SLQF 08 – 25 Credits)

Medium of Study	:	Sinhala/English
Course Fee	:	Local Students - Rs. 31,000/- Foreign Students - US\$ 405

##### Eligibility requirements:

- Should have obtained a degree of at least a duration of 03 years in any stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.  
Or
- Should have obtained a Pracina Pandit degree.  
Or
- Any other qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

#### 02. Master of Arts Degree Course (01 year) (M.A.)

(SLQF 09 - 30 Credits)

Medium of Study	:	Sinhala/English
Stream of Subjects	:	Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ English
Course Fee	:	Local Students - Rs. 45,000/- Foreign Students - US\$ 555

##### Eligibility requirements:

Same Qualifications mentioned above under course No. 01.

#### 03. Master of Arts Degree Course (With Research Component) (02 years) (M.A.)

(SLQF 10 - 60 Credits)

Medium of Study	:	Sinhala / English
Stream of Subjects	:	Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ English
Course Fee	:	Local Students - Rs. 74,500/- Foreign Students - US\$ 705

##### Eligibility requirements:

- Same Qualifications mentioned above under course No. 01.  
Or
- Should have obtained one year M.A. degree from a university/a recognized institute by the UGC.

#### 04. Master of Philosophy Degree Course (M.Phil.) (02 years) (SLQF 11)

**Stream of Subjects** : Buddhist Philosophy/ Buddhist Culture/ Buddhist Civilization/ Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ Archaeology/ Religious Studies and Comparative Philosophy/ English

**Medium of Study** : Sinhala / English

**Course Fee** : Local Students - Rs.100,000/-  
Foreign Students - US\$ 1305

**Eligibility requirements:**

- Should have obtained a Bachelor of Arts (Special) degree with a First Class or Second Class Upper Division relevant to the above stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.  
Or
- Should have obtained one year M.A. degree relevant to the above stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.  
Or
- A candidate who has obtained a Bachelor of Arts (Special) degree with a First Class or Second Class Upper Division or one year M.A. degree or in any other discipline with a post graduate diploma relevant to the above subject stream can be registered for Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.)  
Or
- Any other qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

#### 05. Doctor of Philosophy Degree Course (Ph.D.) (03 years) (SLQF 12)

**Stream of Subjects** : Buddhist Philosophy/ Buddhist Culture/ Buddhist Civilization/ Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ Archaeology/Religious Studies and Comparative Philosophy/ English

**Medium of Study** : Sinhala / English

**Course Fee** : Local Students - Rs. 122,000/-  
Foreign Students - US\$ 1755

**Eligibility requirements:**

- Should have obtained a Postgraduate degree of at least 2 years duration with a research component/ MSc Degree/ M.Phil. degree on one of the above streams of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.  
Or
- Any other qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.
