The applications for the below mentioned Postgraduate Degree Courses will be entertained by the university until **21.12.2018**.

01. Postgraduate Diploma in Buddhist Studies (PGD) (01 year) (SLQF 08 – 25 Credits)

Medium of Study	:	Sinhala/English
Course Fee	:	Local Students - Rs. 21,750/- Foreign Students - US\$ 405

Eligibility requirements:

- Should have obtained a degree of at least a duration of 03 years in any stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- Should have obtained a Pracina Pandit degree.
Or
- Any qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

02. Master of Arts Degree Course (MA) (01 year) (SLQF 09 – 30 Credits)

Medium of Study	:	Sinhala/English
Stream of Subjects	:	Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ English
Course Fee	:	Local Students - Rs. 37,000/- Foreign Students - US\$ 555

Eligibility requirements:

- Should have obtained a degree of at least a duration of 03 years in any stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- Should have obtained a Pracina Pandit degree.
Or
- Any qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

03. Master of Arts Degree (With Research Component) (MA) (02 years) (SLQF 10 – 60 Credits)

Medium of Study	:	Sinhala / English
Stream of Subjects	:	Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ English
Course Fee	:	Local Students - Rs. 57,000/- Foreign Students - US\$ 705

Eligibility requirements:

- Should have obtained a degree of at least a duration of 03 years in any stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- Should have obtained one year M.A. degree from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- Any qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

04. M.Phil Degree Course (02 years) (SLQF 11)

Stream of Subjects : Buddhist Philosophy/ Buddhist Culture/ Buddhist Civilization/ Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ Archaeology/ Religious Studies and Comparative Philosophy/ English

Medium of Study : Sinhala / English

Course Fee : Local Students - Rs. 64,000/-
Foreign Students - US\$ 1305

Eligibility requirements:

- Should have obtained a Bachelor of Arts (Special) degree with a First Class or Second Class Upper Division relevant to the above stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- Should have obtained one year M.A. degree relevant to the above stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- A candidate who has obtained a Bachelor of Arts (Special) degree with a First Class or Second Class Upper Division or one year M.A. degree in any other discipline with a post graduate diploma relevant to the above subject stream can be registered for Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.)
Or
- Any qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

05. Ph.D Degree Course (03 years) (SLQF 12)

Stream of Subjects : Buddhist Philosophy/ Buddhist Culture/ Buddhist Civilization/ Buddhist Studies/ Sinhala/ Pali/ Sanskrit/ Archaeology/Religious Studies and Comparative Philosophy/ English

Medium of Study : Sinhala / English

Course Fee : Local Students - Rs. 79,000/-
Foreign Students - US\$ 1755

Eligibility requirements:

- Should have obtained Postgraduate degree of at least 2 years duration with a research component/ MSSc Degree/ M.Phil degree on one of the above stream of subjects from a university/ a recognized institute by the UGC.
Or
- Any qualification considered equivalent to the above which is accepted by the senate of the university.

The applicants of course no. 05 and 06 will be registered after their qualifications and presentation are approved by the University.
